



## **Prof. Jonathan Ledermann**

Consultant Oncologist, Cancer Research UK and UCL Cancer Trials Centre, UCL Cancer Institute, London, UK

Prof. Jonathan Ledermann graduated from the University of London in 1978. He is a Professor of Medical Oncology in the UCL Cancer Institute, University College London, and an Honorary Consultant Medical Oncologist at UCL Hospitals. He is Head of the Cancer Research UK & UCL Cancer Trials Centre, one of the National Cancer Research Institute (NCRI)-accredited national cancer trials centres, responsible for a significant percentage of the national cancer trials portfolio. He is the lead for medical oncology of Gynaecological Cancer in the North London Gynaecological Cancer Centre, based at UCL Hospitals.

He trained in internal medicine and medical oncology and was a Research Fellow at the Charing Cross Hospital London and the Princess Margaret Hospital and Ontario Cancer Institute in Toronto before joining UCL in 1990.

His principal area of clinical practice and research is in gynaecological cancers. He is the chair of the Ovarian Cancer subgroup of the NCRI Gynaecological Cancer Clinical Studies Group. He is also one of the NCRI representatives on the NCRI Gynecological Cancer Intergroup and has played a central role in the design and conduct of several national and international clinical trials over the last fifteen years. His other areas of research include experimental therapeutics in ovarian cancer and drug resistance. He has lectured and published widely on these areas of research.
